The International Date Line, established in 1884, passes through the mid-Pacific Ocean and roughly follows a 180 degrees longitude north-south line on the Earth.

It is located halfway around the world from the prime meridian—the zero degrees longitude established in Greenwich, England, in 1852. Alaska is in west and Siberia is in East, so date of Siberia is ahead of date of Alaska.

The Bering Strait is a strait of the Pacific, which borders with the Arctic to north. It is located between Russia and the United States.

US iron ore mining is dominated by the precambrian banded iron formation deposits around lake superior in Michigan.

The major agricultural region of the world was first delineated by D. Whittlesey. One of the most satisfactory classifications of agricultural regions in the world was proposed by D. Whittlesey in 1936. Whittlesey employed five criteria to classify agricultural regions in the world:

- a. crop and livestock combination;
- b. intensity of land use;
- c. processing and marketing of farm produce;
- d. degree of mechanisation; and
- e. types and associations of buildings and other structures associated with agriculture.
