

Chile is the world's largest copper producing country. It hosts six of the 10 largest copper mines in the world; the remaining four are located in Peru, Mexico and Indonesia. Escondida copper mine in the Atacama Desert in Chile is the world's largest copper mine by reserve.

Agricultural products processing and market-oriented industries are important industries in this region because it is located far away from the mineral belt of the country. Cotton textile, matchbox, chemical, fish-based industries are important industries of this region.

Plantation agriculture and hydropower led to the development of this region. The location of the petroleum refinery at Kochi has added an advantage to new industries.
