

- The **Tropic of Cancer**, also referred to as the Northern Tropic is 23° 26'13.4" north of the Equator. It is the most northerly circle of latitude on the Earth at which the Sun can be directly overhead.
- The **Tropic of Capricorn**, or Southern tropic, is one of the five major circles of latitude of a map of the Earth. It is 23° 26' 22" south of the Equator. It marks the most southerly latitude at which the sun can appear directly overhead.
- The **Arctic Circle** is the parallel of latitude that runs 66° 33′ 39" (or 66.56083°) north of the Equator and is one of the five major circles of latitude that mark maps of the Earth. Everything north of this circle is known as the Arctic, and the zone just to the south of this circle is the Northern Temperate Zone.
- Antarctic Circle: 66° 33' 39" S. The Antarctic Circle is the parallel of latitude that runs 66° 33′ 39" (or 66.56083°) south of the Equator and is one of the five major circles of latitude that mark maps of the Earth.
