- 3. The **Idukki Dam**, located in Kerala, India, is a 168.91 m tall arch dam. The dam stands between the two mountains Kuravanmala and Kurathimala.
- 4. **Nagarjuna Sagar Dam** is the world's largest masonry dam at the time of its construction, which is built across Krishna River at Nagarjuna Sagar in Guntur district & Nalgonda district of Andhra Pradesh.
