

The total forest and tree cover is 79.42 million hectares, which is 24.16 per cent of the total geographical area.

The reserve encompasses 5,520 km<sup>2</sup> in the states of Tamil Nadu (2537.6 km<sup>2</sup>), Karnataka (1527.4 km<sup>2</sup>) and Kerala (1455.4 km<sup>2</sup>). It forms an almost complete ring around the Nilgiri Plateau.
