Q1. Answer: (d)

Russian-born scientists Andre Geim and Konstantin Novoselov shared the Nobel Prize in physics for "groundbreaking experiments" with an atom-thin material expected to play a large role in electronics. The Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences cited Geim and Novoselov, who are both linked to universities in Britain, for experiments with graphene, a flake of carbon that is only one atom thick.

Experiments with graphene could lead to the development of new material and "the manufacture of innovative electronics," including faster computers, the citation said. Geim, 51, is a Dutch national while Novoselov, 36, holds British and Russian citizenship. Both are natives of Russia and started their careers in physics there.

Note: The Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences has decided to award the Nobel Prize in Physics 2016 with

- 1. one half to David J. Thouless(University of Washington, Seattle, WA, USA) and
- 2. the other half to F. Duncan M. Haldane(Princeton University, NJ, US) and
- 3. J. Michael Kosterlitz(Brown University, Providence, RI, USA)

"for theoretical discoveries of topological phase transitions and topological phases of matter".

Q2. Answer: (a)

Hindi novelish Mithileshwar was awarded on 31 January 2015 with Shrilal Shukla Sahitya IFFCO Award 2014. He is the fourth recipient of this literary award. Mithileshwar belongs to Bhojpur district and is known for his insight into the rural heartland of India.

Q4. Answer: (b)

Dada Saheb Phalke produce Raja Harishchandra in 1913, now known as India's first full-length feature. It was his debut film. He was an Indian producer-director-screenwriter, known as the Father of Indian cinema. He made 95 movies and 26 short films in his career spanning 19 years, till 1937.

Q5. Answer: (d)

Best Film - Agneepath, Barfi!, directed by Anurag Basu, won the award of Best Film at the 14th IIFA Awards. The film stars Ranbir Kapoor, Priyanka Chopra, and Ileana D'Cruz in the lead roles, Ranbir Kapoor won the award of Best Actor for this very film.

Q6. Answer: (b)

The Param Vir Chakra is India's highest military decoration awarded forthe highest degree of valour or self-sacrifice in the presence of the enemy. It can be awarded to officers or enlisted personnel from all branches of the Indian military and can be, and often has been, awarded posthumously.

Q7. Answer: (c)

Dilip Vengsarkar has been honoured with the C.K. Nayudu Lifetime Achievement Award for 2013-14.

Q8. Answer: (d)

Nargis Dutt was the first film actress to be conferred by the Government of India with the Padma Shri title, the fourth highest civilian award in 1958.

In the early 1970s, she became the first patron of the Spastics Society of India, and her subsequent work with the organization brought her recognition as a social worker, and later a Rajya Sabha nomination in 1980.

Q9. Answer: (c)

Bezwada Wilson, a renowned campaigner against manual scavenging, and Carnatic singer T.M. Krishna from Chennai were, on 27 July 2016, named for the prestigious Magsaysay Award.

Other winners are Conchita Carpio-Morales from the Philippines, Dompet Dhuafa from Indonesia, Japan Overseas Cooperation Volunteers and Vientiane Rescue from Laos.

Q10. Answer: (c)

South Korean author, Han Kang, on 16 May 2016 won the 2016 Man Booker International Prize for her novel 'The Vegetarian'.

It is a novel about a woman who "wants to reject human brutality" and gives up eating meat. The novel was translated by Deborah Smith and was published by Portobello Books.

Q11. Answer: (a)

Megastar Amitabh Bachchan was honoured with the Yash Chopra Memorial Award. Amitabh Bachchan is the second recipient of the award. The award was first conferred to melody queen Lata Mangeshkar in 2013.

Q12. Answer: (b)

Indira Gandhi became the first woman to receive the Bharat Ratna in 1971. She served as the Prime Minister of India from 1966 to 1977 and then again from 1980 until her assassination in 1984. Instituted in 1954, the Bharat Ratna is the highest civilian award of India.

Q13. Answer: (d)

Indian shooter Jitu Rai has won silver medal in 50 metre pistol event category. Heena Sidhu has won Gold medal in 10 metre Air Pistol event in women's category.

Q14. Answer: (d)

In 2006, Kejriwal was awarded the Ramon Magsaysay Award for Emergent Leadership recognising his involvement in a grassroots movement Parivartan using right-to-information legislation in a campaign against corruption.

The same year, after resigning from the IRS, he donated his Magsaysay award money as a corpus fund to found the Public Cause Research Foundation, a non-governmental organisation (NGO).

Q15. Answer: (b)

Chameli Devi Jain puraskar is conferred to the journalists. The award, instituted by the Media Foundation has been conferred to Tusha Mittal of Tehelka's Kolkata News Bureau in 2012.
