Wally Grout — Cricket. Arthur Theodore Wallace Grout was a Test cricketer who kept wickets for Australia and Queensland. Grout played in 51 Test matches between 1957 and 1966.

Eusebio — Football. Eusébio da Silva Ferreira, GCIH, GCM.(25 January 1942 – 5 January 2014) was a Mozambican-born Portuguese football forward. He is considered one of the greatest footballers of all time. During his professional career, he scored 733 goals in 745 matches.

Rod Laver — Lawn Tennis. Rodney George “Rod” Laver MBE is an Australian former professional tennis player who holds the record for most singles titles won in the history of tennis, with 200 career titles.

Mark spitz — Swimming. Mark Andrew Spitz is an American former swimmer, Olympic champion, and former world record-holder. He won seven gold medals at the 1972 Summer Olympics, an achievement only surpassed by Michael Phelps.

Q3. Answer: (c)

Vikas Gowda is an Indian discus thrower and Shot putter. He won his first gold medal at the 20th Asian Athletics Championship in Pune in July 2013, with a discus throw of 64.90 meters.;

Now Williams stands behind only Margaret Court's all-time mark of 24. This was Williams' seventh singles trophy at the All England Club — only Martina Navratilova, with nine, has more.

Sri Lankan cricket captain Angelo Mathews was named as captain of the ICC Test Team of the year 2014. The ICC Test Team of the year was chosen by a specially appointed selection panel chaired by the ICC's Cricket committee Chairman Anil Kumble.

Rafael Nadal won the 2013 men's singles U.S. Open title with a 6-2, 3-6, 6-4, 6-1 victory against Novak Djokovic. The win was the 13th major championship victory for Nadal and his second at the U.S. Open.;

Monica Seles was the victim of an on-court attack, when a man stabbed her in the back with a 9-inchlong knife in April 1993.

It happened during a quarterfinal match with Magdalena Maleeva in Hamburg in which Seles was leading 6–4, 4–3, when Günter Parche, an obsessed fan of Steffi Graf, ran from the middle of the crowd to the edge of the court during a break between games and stabbed her.

Q13. Answer: (d)

The men's defending champion, Roger Federer, won the US Open for a fifth consecutive time. In 2008, Federer won one Grand Slam singles title at the US Open over Briton Andy Murray.

Federer was defeated by Nadal in two Grand Slam finals, at the French Open, and at Wimbledon, when he was going for six straight wins to break Bjorn Borg's record.

Note: In 2016 Novak Djokovic was the defending champion, but lost in the final to Stan Wawrinka.;

Q14. Answer: (b)

The opening ceremonies of the 2015 Cricket World Cup took place in New Zealand and Australia on the eve of the beginning of the World Cup hosted by them after 23 years.

Two ceremonies took place at the same time, one in North Hagley Park, Christchurch in New Zealand while the other in Melbourne, Australia.
