**Q1. Answer: (b)**

RAM is not a secondary storage device. Storage consists of storage devices and their media not directly accessible by the Central Processing Unit (CPU).

Secondary storage is all data storage that is not currently in a computer's primary storage or memory.

**Q2. Answer: (d)**

A compiler is a computer program that transforms source code written in a programming language into another computer language the target language, often having a binary form known as object code.

**Q3. Answer: (b)**

The rate at which scanning is repeated in a CRT is called refresh rate.

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**Q4. Answer: (d)**

A programming error is an error which results from bad code in some program involved in producing the erroneous result. But, most of the errors are due to the person using it or giving wrong commands or data to the system. The next most common source is the poorly coded software.

A 56 kbps modem actually only changes its output amplitude, phase, and frequency 1200 times a second, but uses amplitude and phase to encode multiple bits into a single state.

A personal digital assistant (PDA), also known as a palmtop computer, or personal data assistant, is a mobile device that functions as a personal information manager. PDAs are largely considered obsolete with the widespread adoption of smartphones. Nearly all current PDAs have the ability to connect to the Internet.

**Q11. Answer: (b)**

The kernel (also called nucleus) is a computer program that constitutes the central core of a computer's operating system. It is the first program loaded on startup, and then manages the remainder of the startup, as well as input/output requests from software, translating them into data processing instructions for the central processing unit. Its failure is called crash.

**Q12. Answer: (c)**

Optical Mark Reader (OMR) is a special type of optical scanner used to recognize the type of mark made by pen or pencil. It is used where one out of a few alternatives is to be selected and marked. It is specially used for checking the answer sheets of examinations having multiple choice questions.

**Q13. Answer: (c)**

The write-back method involves updating only the cache location and to mark it as updated with an associated flag bit, often called the dirty or modified bit. The main memory location of the word is updated later when the block containing this marked word is to be removed from the cache to make room for a new block.

The reason for the write-back method is that during the time a word resides in the cache, it may be updated several times.

**Q14. Answer: (c)**

Fourth Generation computers are modern-day computers. It began in 1971 when the Intel 4004 chip took the integrated circuit one step further by locating all the components of a computer (central processing unit, memory, and input and output controls) on a minuscule

chip.

The microprocessor is the characteristic of fourth-generation computers, capable of performing all of the functions of a computer's central processing unit.

**Q15. Answer: (d)**

First-Come, First-Served (FCFS) Scheduling is the simplest CPU scheduling algorithm. It is like customers waiting in line at the bank or the post office or at a copying machine. Under it, the process that requests the CPU first is allocated the CPU first. However, the average waiting time under FCFS is long.

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
