The sentence is about an action that Enforcement Directorate made to investigate a firm's link with a drug trafficker. The blank need to be filled by a noun that conveys about that action of ED. "Investigate" is a verb.

"Forensic" is a kind of investigation and cannot be put in the place of it. "Freedom and Correction" don't convey about Investigation, hence, can't be put in the blank
