In passive voice of Simple Present Tense, the verb is written as "is/am/are + 3rd form of Verb". "Condemn, Vague and Explain" are in 1st forms of Verb. Thus, these can't fill the blank. Among the rest two options, a meeting can't be "Stabbed" as only living beings can be stabbed.
