Meaning: Stabbed - cause a sudden sharp sensation or pain, Condemn - to express strong disapproval, Vague - Not clear, Corroborated - Supported by proofs.

The sentence gives details of the stay of a minister. The clause containing blank is in passive voice of Simple Present Tense. In passive voice of Simple Present Tense, the verb is written as **"is/am/are + 3rd form of Verb"**. **"Condemn, Vague and Explain"** are in 1st forms of Verb. Thus, these can't fill the blank. Among the rest two options, a meeting can't be **"Stabbed"** as only living beings can be stabbed.
