To express the events which got completed in past we use past indefinite tense. For this, we use the auxiliary verb 'was/were'.

Since the subject word 'banks' is plural, 'were' should be used. Hence, only option (b) is the correct option.

Q3. Answer: (c)

"Used to" is followed by the verb in continuous form. Therefore sleep is replaced by sleeping

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Q4. Answer: (a)

When the subject is plural, the verb should be used in plural form. Therefore, the subject is followed by helping verb + verb + ing + object

To express the emotion of fear we have the word 'afraid'. This word has been used in options (a) and (d) only.

Hence either of these two can be a correct option. As the given sentence is in simple past tense, only (a) is the correct option.

Option (d) can be ruled out, because, the use of 'had been' suggests the sentence to be in past perfect continuous tense.

Here walking is not a verb but a gerund. And the verb start should be used in simple past tense. Therefore, "starts walks" is replaced by "started walking"

Therefore, it should be 'would have appreciated' in place of 'would appreciate'.
