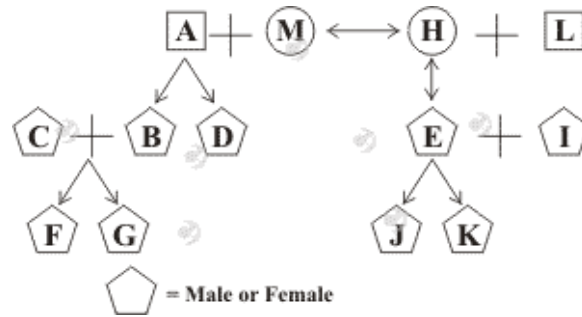
According to the rule D can marry only J or K

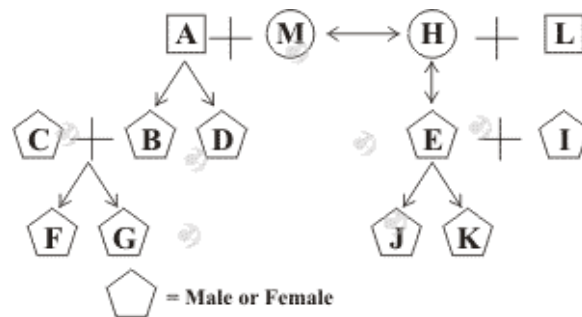
As for more female, the gender of D and E must be female as both are of the same gender
